Spring Lifecycles

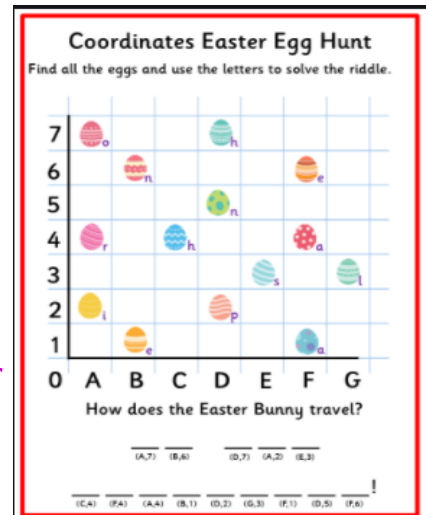

Take a photo of your dish and write out the recipe.

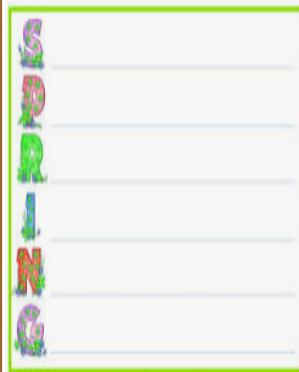


Weave a basket!
