Write your own fairytale story. Who will be the good and bad characters? What magical item will they have? What will be the problem and how will it be resolved?


Grow a beanstalk

Make a fairy light jar and write little notes of all your happiest and magical moments to create magic in a jar.



Write a Newspaper Article

Write an article about a crime scene in one of the fairytales. Interview the witnesses. Add what they stated in your article.



Dress Up



Dress up as fairy tale characters and take photos.

Write A Review



How was this version of the fairytale different from the original. What cultural background was this princess from? What important message does this film give?

Draw A Map



Draw a map and use co-ordinates to find the hidden castle .

Design A Crown



Design and make your own crown.


Paper Mache Carriage

Design A Castle


Create your own castle using cardboard and junk. You can use kitchen rolls, smarties or cringle tubes to make the towers on the castle. Will it have a drawbridge?
