## Dinosaur Egg Hunt

Freeze your toy dinosaur in a large kinder egg case. Once frozen, hide them around the house or garden. You need to find them before they hatch! Take photos and bring them in.



## Dinosaur Fossils

You can press your dinosaurs into playdough, plastisine or salt dough. Lift it up and you will see the imprint that is left behind.



## Dinosaur Extinction

Why did the dinosaurs die out?  
Do some research to find out the theories behind how the dinosaurs became extinct. Write an article on your findings.



## Film Review

Write a review on your favourite film or book about dinosaurs.



## Top Trumps

Write a fact file on different dinosaurs. Can you create a game of top trumps?





### Dinosaur Diorama

Make a pre-historic scene with dinosaurs using shoe boxes, egg boxes, kitchen rolls and other junk material. You can also use natural materials such as stones, leaves and twigs.



### Hatching Dinosaur Eggs

You can use papermache on balloons, paper plates and even plastisine.

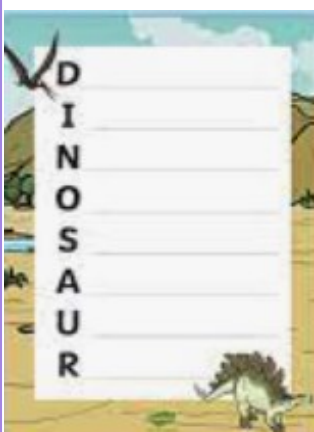
### Dinosaur Feet
