Create a 3D model.

Write a fact file on how the moon influences the seasons.



Make a list

Make a list of fiction and non-fiction books about seasons.

Weather report

Create a weather report. You can use the weather symbols.



Write a report on hibernation

Write a report on hibernating animals and how they adapt their bodies to adjust to the cold seasons.



Climate change poster

Make a poster on the extreme weathers during the different seasons, for example bushfires during the summer or hurricanes during autumn and winter.

Write a story

Write a story about a tree in the changing seasons. What changes does the tree face? What happens to the leaves? How does each season make it feel?



Make a bird feeder.

Make a bird feeder using recycled materials to feed the birds during all seasons, especially winter.

Why do some animals migrate? During what seasons does migration occur? Where do they migrate to?



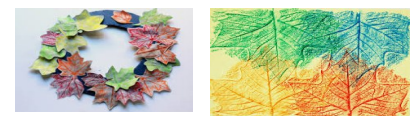
Experiment

Make a collage of a tree from different seasons materials.



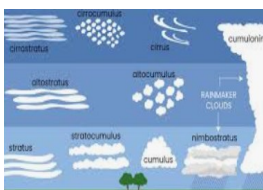
Make a diorama

Flowers blossom in spring and summer. Paint or collage flowers with tissue paper. Make a 3D model of a flower.



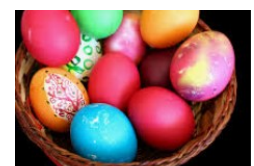
