



**This half term the 'Homework Challenge' helps you to learn and be creative about food.**

Ever so gorgeous


Always juicy and sweet

Design a menu for a special family meal. Make it look smart, like one you get at a wedding or fancy restaurant!




## Family Favourites


## Food Art
