Watch your favourite superhero cartoon or film and design a poster to advertise it. How will you make people want to see it?



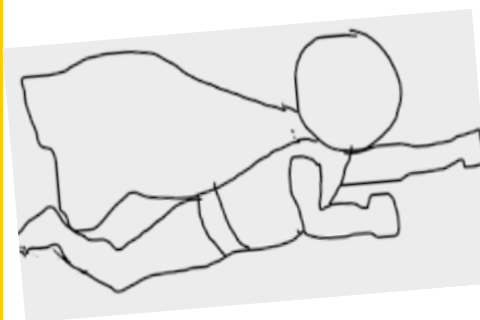
Superheroes Need Accessories!
