Create a map of the area. Can you use directional language to show where the eggs are hidden?

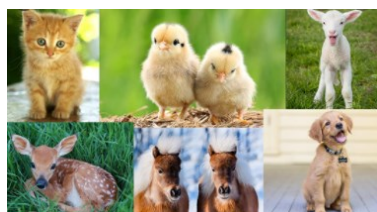


Spring Babies

Can you make your own Easter Bonnet?

Use materials that you have at home to make it. Cover your bonnet with lots of things that remind you about Easter and Springtime

Weather across the world

Spring in England is from March to June. It can have very mixed weather!

But is it Spring all over the world at this time of year?

Research what season it is for some other countries.

What is the weather like there?

Create your own weather forecast for a different place. Record yourself or take some pictures!

What do you think of when you think of Spring? Do you think of chicks, lambs, Easter, eggs, daffodils?

Why are these things associated with Spring? Research some of the symbols of Spring the meanings behind them.

Create a Springtime poem or poster.



Easter Bunny Route Finder

The Easter Bunny has to travel all over the world delivering eggs.

Pick some places that the Easter bunny needs to visit. How long will it take them to get there? Will they travel by air, land or water? Which countries will they need to travel through?

Create a map and plot the routes onto it.
